**Match fee is \$10.00 per relay = \$5.00 to the club / \$5.00 to the league**

**Junior shooters under age 21 \$6.00 per relay = \$3.00 to the club / \$3.00 to the league**

## **LEAGUE RULES & REGULATIONS**

Email confirmation period for relay positions runs from midnight of the Sunday prior to the match to the Wednesday prior to the match closing @ 10pm. Relay rosters will be emailed no later than Friday morning. This process is totally on a first come, first served basis.

First relay shooters **MUST** arrive no later than 8:45am, this allows for a prompt 9am start.

All type rifles can participate, there will be two rifle classes, CMP class & "Unlimited" class.

CMP class rifles and shooters must abide by CMP Rimfire Sporter rules.

Unlimited class rifles and shooters can use - shooting coats/gloves - higher power scopes - and use rifles heavier than the 7.5 lbs limit of the CMP class.

League prize money will be paid out to both rifle classes 1st place = \$25 ; 2nd = \$20 ; 3rd = \$15

The 10 highest scores of the first 13 matches will be counted toward final average. If all 13 matches are shot then only the highest 10 will be used for final average. If you do not have 10 scores for record then you will not have a final average nor be eligible for the X - Count match.

Both rifle classes will be using the small targets for all positions in the first 13 league matches. The 14th match will be the sanctioned CMP match, it will not be counted for league average. The 15th and final match will be the X - Count match for all qualified shooters, this match will also not be counted for league average. At the X - Count match shooters will be shooting for X count only. For each X scored on CMP small targets a ticket will be put in a drawing for prize money. Each shooter can only win once - so if your name is drawn again it will be discarded and another ticket drawn.
