RANGE SAFETY RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Treat every firearm as if it were loaded.
2. No one will go forward of the firing line until the "all clear" is agreed to.
3. Keep the action open and the firearm unloaded, except when on the firing line, ready to fire.
4. A member or range officer must supervise non-members or juniors while on club property.
5. Know your firearm and ammunition. Have only the proper ammunition on the firing line for the firearm you are using.
6. Always point the muzzle of the firearm in a safe direction, down range and in the air.
7. Keep your finger off the trigger except when ready to shoot.
8. Be sure of your target and what is beyond.
9. Only approved targets are to be used on all ranges (no glass, cinder blocks, rocks, plastic jugs, etc.).
10. Firearms will not be handled when anyone is forward of the firing line. All firearms will be benched or racked and made safe before going forward of the firing line.
11. Ear and eye protection is the responsibility of all persons on the range and is highly recommended.
12. Know, obey and understand all range commands and range terminology. On the command "cease fire", immediately bench and make safe all firearms.
13. No alcohol or controlled substance either in or on the person is allowed on any range.
14. Shooting hours are 9:30 AM until sunset.
15. Non-Club members cannot use the Club facilities without prior approval from a club director.
16. **PROOF OF MEMBERSHIP MUST BE CARRIED WHEN ON BCSA CLUB GROUNDS. PLEASE DISPLAY YOUR MEMBERSHIP CARD IN THE ENCLOSED CARD HOLDER.**
